

## Fish Hub Update

The Community Development Partnership (CDP) of Cape Cod and Amplifier Strategies, of San Francisco are happy to announce the release of the Fish Hub Knowledge Center. The Knowledge Center is an interactive help center to share best practices in community based fisheries management. The CDP has shared a few tools and tips, including how to set up and manage a permit bank and develop program applications. Through a grant from the National Fish and Wildlife Foundation (NFWF), the CDP also developed an online Help Center with FAQs to support new users as they navigate the Fish Hub, along with video tutorials about how to use the Fish Hub online suite of tools. The Fish Hub project recently welcomed the Penobscot East Resource Center as a new partner contributing to the expansion of the Boat Plan application. With fishing organizations in Cape Cod, Penobscot East and Morro Bay working together to design the new features of the Boat Plan, this update will include the ability to plan for multi-species fisheries and varying trip types, as well as tools for comparing plans to current settlement sheets. These new features are scheduled for release this Fall.
